ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Assigns duties and directs crew engaged in the maintenance and construction of the water distribution system
- Makes requests for utility locates
- Makes taps; installs and repairs mains, services, fire hydrants, and valves; assists with street and yard repairs
- Inventories material and makes arrangements for delivery to job sites as required
- Reports quality and quantity of work performed by employees
- Prepares and maintains required reports and records such as daily crew reports; valve, hydrant and main records; field changes on work prints; work orders; vehicle and equipment usage
- Serves as spokesman for the crew when dealing with other governmental agencies, contractors, and customers
- Works overtime when necessary to construct or make emergency repairs in the distribution system
- Receives emergency after-hours calls and investigates calls received
- Serves in on-call rotation to respond to after-hours emergency repairs to the distribution system

- Coordinates water outages with customers and work teams
- Coordinates with and assists Restoration Crew Leader as needed
- Serves as Restoration Crew Leader in their absence as assigned
- Maintains a safe working environment
- Performs other duties as required or assigned by management

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to interpret blueprints, sketches, and written or oral instructions
- Shall possess a valid Iowa license and have a good driving record
- Ability to operate tools and equipment pertinent to the water distribution field
- Ability to prepare daily written reports
- Must be able to respond to emergency calls within 15 minutes when called
- Must be able to effectively communicate with internal and external customers
- Basic knowledge of plumbing
- Basic knowledge of the use of construction equipment
- Requires a minimum of 3 years of experience in construction
- Must obtain an Iowa DNR Grade 2 Distribution Certificate

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

- Ability to handle up to 100 lbs. and lift 60 lbs.
- Ability to work in confined spaces.
- Ability to climb and descend ladders.
- Ability to squat, bend over, and kneel for extended periods of time.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:

- Frequent exposure to traffic and machine noise.
- Frequent exposure to adverse weather conditions.
- Works in excavations with mud and water.
- Limited exposure to hazardous chemicals
